Initial Consultation

In our consultation, we'll focus on your specific ideas for the artwork. It's helpful if you come prepared with a clear direction—whether that's referencing one of my previous pieces, specifying a size, or sharing a general theme or style you have in mind. This allows us to ensure we're aligned before moving forward.

Understanding Costs

Pricing for commissions is determined by factors such as size, materials, and project complexity. While commissions typically begin at \$300 NZD, we'll discuss a general range during our consultation so you can have clarity on costs before we move ahead. Once the details are finalised, we'll agree on a set price to continue with

Initial Design Fee

To get started on the design phase, there is an initial design fee charged at an hourly rate between \$50 - \$70+ NZD, depending on the project's intricacies. This covers my time brainstorming, sketching, and sharing material, colour, or texture samples to help you visualise the final piece. Please note, this fee is non-refundable, as it compensates for the time spent in this crucial phase.

Design Review

Once the design is ready, you'll have the opportunity to review it and suggest changes while we're still in the sketch phase. Once you've approved the design, we'll move forward with creation.
